Management of the various types of degradable and non-degradable waste

Gurukul Degree College has taken a great step towards Waste management by composting the Waste materials of the Degree College plus horticulture Waste in the pits.

Dust bins are placed in all the classrooms of the college in order to collect solid waste. In addition to this one dust bin is kept in Principal chamber and staff room, ladies staff room administration office, library room and computer lab respectively for the same. Students and staff are well directed to make best use of dust bins.

On daily basis solid waste collected from the college is disposed in the vehicle of city municipal corporation.

Underground sewage disposal pits are constructed. Liquid waste is drained to sewage pits after safety monitoring. The liquid waste is autoclaved and drained.

E-waste at present is handed over to electronic shops. The management plans to take effective measures to manage e-waste in future.
